- Establish *Center for Rotary Wing Air Platform Development & Acquisition, Test & Evaluation*
- Realign Ft. Rucker, AL by relocating ATTC to Redstone and consolidating with RTTC
- New Test Center: "Redstone Test Center (RTC)"
- End state of this recommendation builds upon existing technical expertise and facilities in place and provides focused support for future aviation technological advances in rotorcraft development.
- Completion: September 2011
